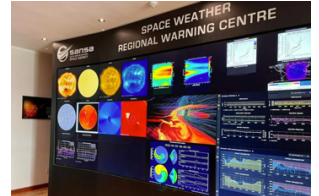


IGU-CGE Conference Field Trip: Geomorphology, SANSA & Protection Tourism
